Document Name: Appeals Committee Terms of Reference (GC)

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1 Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this Document is to outline the membership, tenure and frequency of meeting of the Appeals Committee at Griffith College.

2 Document Contents

2.1 Terms of Reference

Appeals Committee serves as a non-partial appeals avenue for students and staff of Griffith College who have exhausted all other avenues of appeal.

Appeals Committee reports to Academic Board on academic appeals and to Executive Committee for non-academic appeals.

The key areas of responsibility for appeals committee are:

- The consideration of appeals once all other appeals avenues have been exhausted, including, but not limited to:
 - exclusion for unsatisfactory academic performance;
 - imposition of penalties for academic misconduct;
 - review of marks application;
 - transfer of provider;
 - administrative decisions of the College.
- Provision of feedback on any apparent problems arising from the administration of policies and procedures.
- Provision of feedback to decision-makers on overturned decisions, to allow for a continuous improvement of the application of policies and procedures.

The Appeals Committee may consider all relevant evidence and documentation relating to the appeal processes, findings of fact and penalties imposed. In doing so, the Appeals Committee has the authority, to conclude that the findings of the original appeal process were incorrect, to impose a lesser penalty or to make a finding that due process has not been followed, resulting in unfairness to the student and thus warranting the allegation being referred back to the Relevant Senior Officer to be dealt with afresh.

2.2 Membership

The membership of the Appeals Committee is dependent on the nature of the appeal, and the campus location of the student. A combination of the following staff will be gathered, in accordance with the <u>Student Complaints and Appeals Policy:</u>
